Age-Friendly Program Cycle

Planning (Years 1-2): Involve older adults in assessment process, develop goals and create an action plan

Continual Improvement (5-year membership cycle)

Implementation (Years 3-5): Implement action plan, monitor indicators

Evaluate: Measure and document progress, identify successes and gaps



Domains of Livability

The World Health Organization has identified eight domains that influence health and quality of life.



<u>Civic Participation & Employment</u>: Options for paid work, entrepreneurship, postretirement training, volunteering, and the chance for residents of all ages to engage in the creation of policies relevant to their lives.



<u>Communication & Information</u>: Access to information about community activities and services through multiple formats adapted for sensory impairments and access to computers, internet and automated information.



<u>Community Support & Health Services</u>: Access to homecare services, medical care and programs that promote wellness, voluntary support, emergency planning, aging specialist and coordinated care across the continuum.



<u>Housing</u>: Access to a range of affordable housing options, home modification programs, home maintenance services and alternative living options to age in place.



Outdoor Spaces & Buildings: Availability of safe and accessible facilities for recreation, shopping and services; walkways; parking areas; public restrooms; and public parks.



Respect & Social Inclusion: Access to an environment that encourages reverent treatment and interactions, intergenerational activities, and involvement by residents of all ages, abilities and incomes.



Social Participation: Affordable and accessible opportunities across a range of social activities with peers and younger people, countering isolation.



<u>Transportation</u>: Availability of safe and affordable transportation to needed services and desired activities; specialized services; pedestrian and cycling; roadway design and signage; and travel after transitioning from driving.



Age-Friendly Public Health

The Trust for America's Health and the Florida Department of Health with funding through the John A. Hartford Foundation have completed a pilot program that worked with 37 of Florida's 67 county health departments; ensuring planning and programming that includes a focus on older adults.

This led to the development of the

5 C's of an Age-Friendly Public Health System.

Age-Friendly Public Health

Manatee County had several key areas of focus which included:

- Worked with the community paramedics program to provide care coordination for older adults when discharged from the hospital.
- DOH developed a handout for older adults focused on suicide prevention and mental health resources
- Partnered with community organizations to provide advanced care planning at no cost to older adults
- DOH joined a multi-sector coalition to work on falls prevention.

Manatee County Community Health Survey

The DOH in Manatee County along with the Manatee Care Health Alliance just concluded a community health survey to find out what the residents see as health concerns and community needs. The results will shape the 2021-2023 Community Health Improvement Plan. Look for results in 2021.

SAFE CELEBRATE AT HOME



Prepare traditional dishes with those in your household

Watch parades, sporting events, and movies at home



Shop online instead of in stores



LESS SAFE IF YOU GATHER, DO SO WISELY



Keep it small and stay local



Stay outside if possible and ensure proper ventilation if indoors



Wear masks and social distance



Wash or sanitize your hands regularly, especially before eating



Avoid contact with non-attendees for 14 days before and after your gathering



UNSAFE AVOID...



Large gatherings, especially indoors



Potlucks, buffets, or other shared food



Places with crowds, such as stores, parades, running events, and sports



Contact with anyone who is sick or may have been exposed to COVID-19
