Have you ever wished you had written a memoir or a family history?

Often AAUW members are interested in this, so Jan L. Fishler (an author, writing coach, and speaker who has worked with branches around the country) set up a live Zoom course, **Your Memoir: Just Write**It! on Thursdays during the month of August, from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Pacific Time.

You know your life an amazing life. Make sure future generations read about it or your legendary stories and experiences. Your Memoir: Just Write It! is for you.

In four 2-hour sessions, she plans to show you how to tap into your subconscious and make memoir-writing easy and fun. You'll also:

- § Discover the parts of your story that need to be told.
 - § Collect and organize content.
 - § Bring your characters to life.
- § Write scenes and dialogue like a pro in the comfort of your home or office.

The course is divided in to four session each focusing on a topic. At the end of the month, you will know what to include in your memoir, how to write realistic dialogue, how to craft compelling scenes and much more—all in the company of other university women.

She will provide examples and worksheets as well as time for questions and answers. Sharing is encouraged but optional. You will have access to recorded Zoom calls for a full week following each class. After the course, you'll be invited to join a private Facebook group where you will receive answers to your questions and get feedback on your writing. There will also be a weekly Live Zoom call the following month to talk about your memoir and to provide encouragement and support to help you get it done!

Your Memoir: Just Write It! 10+ hour course typically costs \$199 but AAUW members pay the discounted price of \$99.

If family and friends have been encouraging you to write about your life or if you've been thinking about recording your family's history, now is time to start.
